

HERON POOL RULES

Heron Pool is open daily for lodge and touring anglers
Caistor Lakes reserves the right to stop / restrict fishing at ANY TIME.

Day ticket anglers can fish during the times below.

October – March 8 - 4pm

April – September 8 - 5pm

Aggression, verbal or otherwise towards staff, public or other anglers WILL NOT be tolerated.

Do not interfere with any aerators, they are on or off for a reason

Do not leave rods unattended in the water

Please make yourself aware of the fire assembly points

Anglers to fish from pegs, not from the bank

No keep nets allowed

ALL nets and mats to be dipped at the dip tanks provided BEFORE fishing

All fish to be handled with care, unhooked correctly and placed back into the water quickly and safely

Unhooking mats to be used at all times

Any pictures of fish to be taken ASAP – fish to be over a mat or cradle

DO NOT STAND UP OR WALK ABOUT WITH FISH IN YOUR HANDS

Barbless hooks only

Maximum hook size 10

No dog or cat meat or biscuits

Caistor Lakes house pellets to be used

No Joker or Bloodworm

No braided main line

NO NUTS ALLOWED

No drones

No wading or swimming

Current EA Licence is required.

Remove all rubbish and placed in the bins provided

Dispose of left over bait in the bins or take away with you. Do not throw it in the lakes.

Take care when walking around the lakes.

Any damages to anglers equipment must be paid for. All tackle and equipment is the responsibility of the owner.

Anglers must not engage in any activity or angling practice that endangers fish stock, wildlife or water bodies of Caistor Lakes.
